We are happy to announce that the two classrooms in Tanzania are finished since May and the classes already started.

On 19 May 2016, the opening ceremony of the new school building took place in Makuyuni. All Makuyuni teachers and students, VIPs and other invited guests, including Sahayata representatives joined the ceremony.

When we arrived at the school building, the school director greeted us immediately. Other honored guests (district representative, governor, council and mayor) arrived shortly after us. The pupils were just having lunch. This was great for the children, because usually no lunch is provided at the Makuyuni school. This means that the children have to wait for a meal until being back home.

A teacher of the school opened the ceremony and guided us through the program. Firstly the children sang the Makuyuni school song. Afterwards speeches were given by the district representative, the mayor, school director, followed by the Sahayata president. After these speeches the students of the higher classes presented a dance. We then went to the new classroom.

For us, the inauguration of the new classroom was a particular highlight. We had to wear a Shuka (Original Masai cloth) and had to cut the ribbon attached to the door. Afterwards selected students went to their place and presented a song.



Finally the Sahayata logo was revealed and the guests were invited to dinner.
